### Location Description:

**Vancouver:** 2 Vancouver Heritage houses:  
1 residence for men, 1 for women - Total 22 beds

**Richmond: TPRS-M:** 1 house in Richmond - 9 beds for men

**TPRS-W:** 1 house in Richmond - 9 beds for women

**Admission Criteria:** Clients are required to be abstinent for a minimum of 48 - 72 hours prior to intake. Clients are required to have a TB test upon intake.

**Admission Restrictions:** Persons taking certain medications or presenting with psychogenic disorders requiring intervention beyond the scope of the program are not accepted at this time. Persons experiencing acute withdrawal symptoms.

**Priority clients:** Richmond residents, pregnant women, homeless, HIV, IV drug users, in Detox, individuals in certain crisis or unsafe/unstable situations

**Intake on Weekend:** Yes

**Admission Details:** Cell phones and motor vehicles are discouraged. Residents are limited to 2-3 medium bags. Bicycles are permitted.

**Program Description:**

- Client centered Individual and Group Counselling
- Life Skills, employment and education training and referrals
- Expressive Art Therapy, Yoga, Acupuncture, Aromatherapy – other stress and coping management techniques
- Domestic Violence Substance Abuse (DVSA) Program
- Recreational Therapy, Physical Fitness and Nutritional Planning
- Relapse Prevention
- Discharge, Transition and Continuing Care Planning
- Bio-psycho-social spiritual, client centered approach
- 12-step and other community support programs incorporated
